2. Your teacher will give you an adjective, you have to write a sentence which represents that feeling (see example).

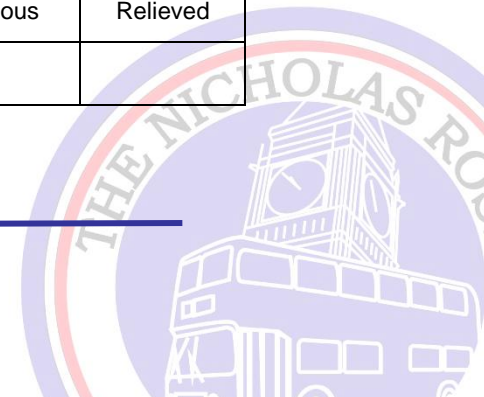

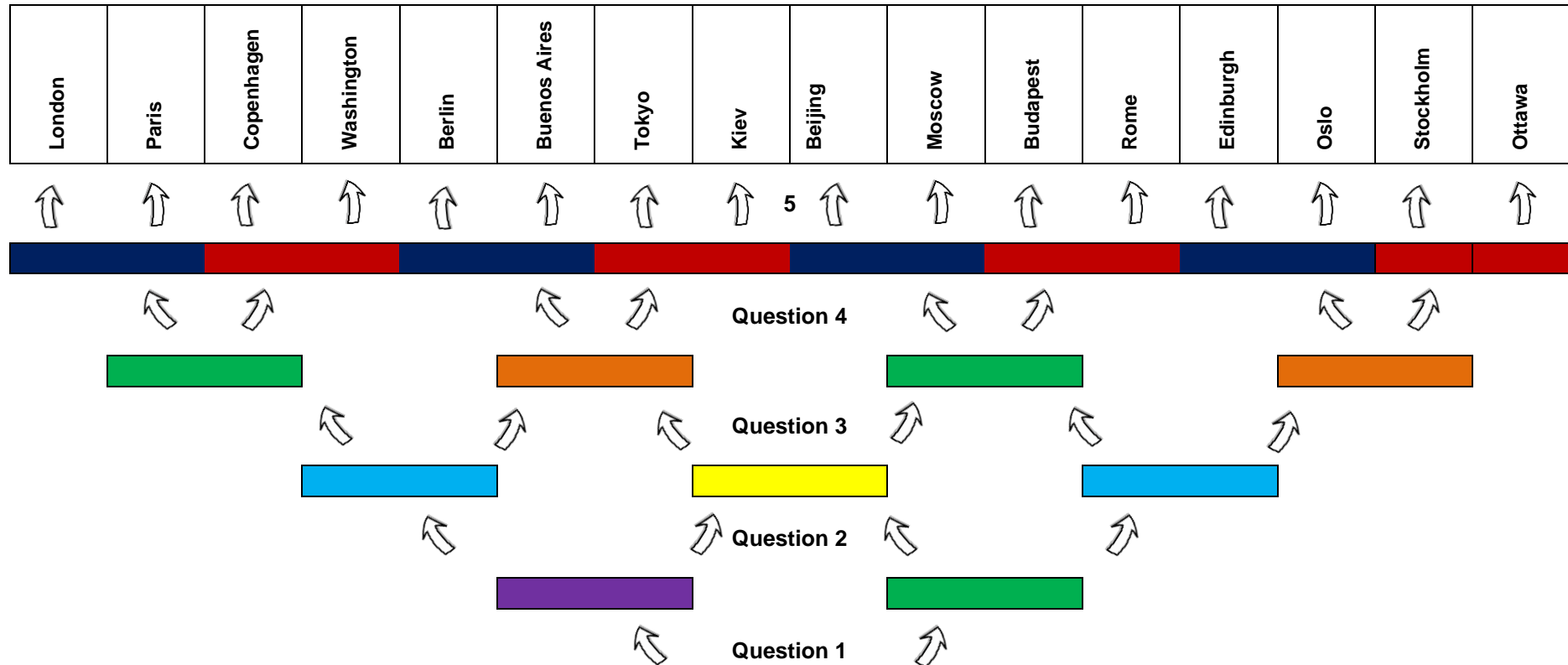
